General tips

CHANGE WATER EVERY 1-2 DAYS

this helps prevent bacterial growth, ensuring your flowers stay fresh and hydrated longer.

USE FLORISTS SCISSORS IF POSSIBLE

this they create clean, precise cuts on the stems, reducing damage and allowing better water absorption, which helps flowers stay fresh longer.

REMOVE LEAVES BELOW WATERLINE

submerged leaves can decay, promoting bacterial growth in the water, which can block the stems' ability to absorb water and shorten the flowers' lifespan.

KEEP ARRANGEMENTS IN A COOL AREA

and away from direct sunlight, heat, and drafts.

MOST FLOWERS PREFER INDIRECT SUNLIGHT

direct sun can cause wilting.

ALWAYS MAKE DIAGONAL CUT

unless stated otherwise cuts to increase water uptake


WATER SHOULD BE ROOM TEMPERATURE

it helps flowers absorb water more efficiently without shocking the stems

STURDY BUT SENSITIVE TO BACTERIA



COVER 60% OF STEMS

Change water every 2 days. Recut stems regularly. remove leaves below the waterline. Use a flower food mix, or add a small amount of sugar and vinegar to the water to feed and protect against bacteria.






Dianthus

STRAIGHT CUT JUST ABOVE A NODE



ALL YEAR



DURABLE AND LONG-LASTING



COVER 7-10 CM OF STEMS

Avoid placing them near fruit, as the ethylene gas will speed up wilting. Recut stems every 2 days, and change the water regularly.





Tulipa **CUT SEASON DELICATE WATER PRO TIP**

STRAIGHT CUT ACROSS THE BASE



LATE WINTER AND SPRING



PRONE TO WILTING AND BENDING



COVER 7-10 CM OF STEMS

Remove leaves below the waterline. Tulips continue to grow after cutting, so give them space. Keep them in a cool environment, and add a few ice cubes to the water to slow down blooming.





FOR BEST RESULTS, DIP STEMS IN BOILING WATER FOR 30 SECONDS OR CRUSH THE ENDS.



LATE SPRING TO EARLY FALL



VERY SENSITIVE TO DEHYDRATION



COVER WHOLE STEM

Hydrangeas drink from their petals too, so mist them regularly. Keep the water levels high and change the water daily.



LATE SPRINT TO FALL



RESILIENT BUT REQUIRE PROPER CARE



COVER WHOLE STEM

Remove leaves below the waterline. Change water every 2 days and remove any faded flowers to encourage longer bloom life. Keep away from direct sunlight and heat.



LATE SPRINT TO EARLY SUMMER




DELICATE PETALS, BUT STURDY STEMS



COVER 15-20 CM OF STEMS

Change water daily and keep them in a cool area to slow down the blooming process. Peonies tend to open quickly, so placing them in a cool spot will help them last longer.






Ranunculus

TYPICALLY APRIL TO EARLY JUNE



THIN PETALS



COVER 10-15 CM OF STEMS

Change water daily, and recut stems every 2 days. Keep them in a cool spot to slow down blooming and avoid drafts.



LATE WINTER TO SPRINT



RELATIVELY HARDY BUT REQUIRES PROPER CARE



COVER 10-15 CM OF STEMS

Change the water every 2 days and keep in a cool spot. Matthiola can benefit from regular misting to keep them hydrated.




SMALL BLOOMS CAN WILT IF NOT CONDITIONED PROPERLY



CHECK WATER DAILY

Tanacetum drinks a lot — check water levels daily, especially in warm weather. For a wild-garden feel in bouquets, mix it with contrasting textures, but avoid pairing it with heavy water drinkers like hydrangeas unless you're refreshing water often.






Alstromeria

ALL YEAR



RELATIVELY HARDY BUT REQUIRES PROPER CARE



COVER 10-15 CM OF STEMS

Don't force open closed blooms - Alstroemeria opens gradually. Buy them when most buds are still closed for longer vase life. Keep water clean and deep, and you'll enjoy a beautiful, slow-blooming show for days!






Viburnum

TYPICALLY APRIL TO EARLY JUNE



CAN HOLD UP FOR 5-7 DAYS



COVER 10-15 CM OF STEMS

Viburnum has woody stems, which means crushing or splitting the base of the stem can help it absorb water more effectively. You can also dip the freshly cut end in boiling water for 10 seconds to prevent early wilting — this seals the stem and boosts water intake.






Greenery








COVER 10-15 CM OF STEMS

Change water regularly and recut stems. Greenery can last longer than flowers, and many varieties, like eucalyptus, can be dried and reused.
